

# FAQ – CITY LIFE 2019

*As of December 19, 2018*

**1) What are the dates and locations for City Life 2019?**

There will be two City Life teams in 2019, at two separate locations. June 1 – 8, City Life East will take place at the Urban Hope Training Center in Philadelphia. During the week of June 11 – 18, City Life West will be located at the Urban Hope Training Center - Los Angeles. You will be asked to arrive at your team's location on the first day (June 1 or June 11, depending on which team you are on and you will depart from that same location on the last day (as needed, airport transportation will be provided to a designated airport for both arrivals and departures). You will bring your own bedding and the team will use their UHTC location as home base.

**2) What will a normal day be like and what will the team be doing?**

Each day will begin with time to get ready, eat breakfast, and have time with the Lord. We will then head out each day to experience ministry in the city and get some "hands on" opportunities to serve others. Depending on which location you are at, we plan to visit some large church campuses, serve others thru food ministry, share our faith at places like Reading Terminal Market and Huntington Beach, and do a few "touristy" things like visiting the Liberty Bell & Rocky Steps, or Downtown Disney and Hollywood.

**3) How big will the team be?**

We can take approximately 12 per team, which includes students and leaders.

**4) How do the teams travel around?**

We will travel to our various ministry/city-experience sites in 15 passenger vans.

**5) Is it safe where we will be going?**

I'm sure you realize we would never knowingly put anyone in harm's way. But we will be out with people and we will be doing ministry in a number of locations (always in groups, never alone). This will be our 46th year of providing high school students with short term ministry opportunities so hopefully that speaks to our background of care and wisdom with students while providing fulfilling and enriching service experiences.

**6) What is the support total for City Life and do I have to pay that all at once?**

The City Life support total for 2019 has not been announced yet, but will likely be close to the 2018 total, which was \$585.00 – this includes a non-refundable confirmation deposit of \$100. The deposit will secure your spot on the team, so that needs to come in first once you know you are accepted. The remaining balance is due sometime in mid-May.
